Pink Peony

The photographer wanted this gold frame to be used, for its profile of leaves and pearls, but not the gold finish. She wanted the frame to match the color of the flower and have the photo look as if it was floating in the frame!

We have been called magicians before ... so no problem!



We painted the frame and fillet pure white, then red, brushed a lighter pink on and a touch of orange, and voila the frame and fillet matched perfectly!

We mounted the photo, cut the fillet in reverse so the photo would sit in the lip edge and not fall through. Two pieces of museum glass were cut and the fillet/photo was attached to the back glass. The front glass is kept off the photo by the fillet edge. This glass/photo package was all placed into the frame and a final fit was done.



We magician performed our magic again!
